Historical Memory

As the Berman Family enters upon its second century in the United States, many of the folk stories relating to its history in "Mother Russia" and during our early years here get lost. This is, therefore, an urgent request that we attempt to salvage some of those memories before they are lost unto the generations. Please share with us any vignettes and stories of interest that you may remember – or have been told – and inquire of your parents/grandparents/great grandparents to elicit "stories" of interest. The "stories" that are provided will be saved and, as appropriate, incorporated into the family history, **This Is Us**.

There is the family story that when Chonon & Khasia left Russia to immigrate to America they were asked by a neighbor (or perhaps another relative) to take their child with them as their own. The story is that the wife of the neighbor/relative was ineligible to enter the United States because of an illness and her husband would not leave her. Chonon & Khasia did take the child with them as their own. Indeed, their immigration records reveal that they were accompanied by two of their children, Harry (true) and Gustave (untrue). Gus had previously entered the country and was living here.

The questions submitted for answers: What was the name of the child? ...and does anyone have any additional information concerning him?

GENEALOGY

For some of us, genealogy is a fascinating pursuit combining family and history, a personal perspective of the life and times of the past. Sometimes one discovers relationships that may or may not be...that heretofore have been unknown.

For several years we have been in communication with a Sue Geiger (now of Simi Valley, CA) who has been attempting to research her firmly held belief that our families are related. She believes that her great grandfather, Joseph Morris Berman, was Chonon Berman's brother – or at least a cousin. Her evidence is credible:

- (1) "My grandmother was Rose Berman Lederer. Her parents were Joseph Morris Berman and Rebecca "Bluma" Lear/Lehr who emmigrated to New Haven about between 1888 and 1890 from Elizabetgrad, Russia. Joseph Berman was a plumber, and he lived in the early 1900's at 41 Broad Street in New Haven. According to a New Haven directory, (C)Honon and Benjamin Berman moved to that same address in 1907. In 1909, Barnett and Benjamin Berman, both tailors, are living at that address. Therefore, I think it's very possible that Joseph Berman and (C)Honon were brothers or cousins. Joseph was about 12 years older than (C)Honon."
- (2) Sue's grandmother's brother's name was Barnett Berman, a lawyer in New Haven. The name "Barnett" appears in both families.
- (3) Sue's great uncle Benton Berman was born December 1, 1879 in Russia, emigrated in 1891 with his father, and died December 24, 1929. His son, Benton Berman, was born February 14, 1917 and died in 2003. Yes, we also have a Benton Berman!
- (4) Sue had retained a professional Jewish genealogist, Ted Gostin, to research the New Haven ancestors. Quoting Ted Gostin, she has written:

"In 1898, Joseph Berman (who was a plumber) is listed as living at 63 York and working at 32 Oak. Also living at 63 York is an Isaac Berman, tailor." I noticed that several of (C)Honon's sons were tailors. Do you know this Isaac Berman? Ted

Gostin also suggests the following: "One of the sons of (C)Honon Berman is named Barnett. (My Joseph Berman, as I told you, also had aq son Barnett.) This suggests to me that an ancestor of Joseph and (C)Honon Berman was named Barnett and that both sons were named after him."

Sue has also provided the additional information that according to her great uncle Barnett Berman's biography in the Yale School of Law yearbook, his grandparents were Joseph Maurice and Esther Ida (Astrachan) Berman of Elisabethgrad.

Of further genealogical interest is the fact that Sue's great grandmother's name was Rebecca Lear Berman who had a sister Minnie (Minka) Lear. Her parents were Anna and Jacob Solomon Lear. Her brother Solomon Lear had a daughter also named Minnie Lear. Within our Chonon Berman family there is Mina Lear (1902-1043), the wife of Morris David Berman and the mother of Leila Joan Berman Schulman (1927-2009) and Samuel Lear Berman. There is a synergy.

Some publications have crossword puzzles. The Berman Family Announcer has genealogy puzzles. Can you contribute to the solution of this puzzle. Any information that can be discovered to establish the relationship, if any, between the families of Chonon Berman and that of Sue Geiger will be most welcome.

See what you can discover....and pass it on. Who knows, there may well be an interconnect betewwn or among the families of Chonon Berman, the family of Sue Geiger and even the family of **Lillian Berman Berman**, the wife of **Gustave Berman**.
