BELARUS

(Because of the substantial interest engendered by the earlier publication of excerpts from the second of a series of presentations by Rochelle Goldberg Ruthchild, a research associate at the Davis Center for Russian and Eurasian Studies at Harvard University, to the Jewish Genealogical Society of Greater Boston entitled "Jewish History of Belarus", we are serializing the Program Report of the first lecture that appeared in the March 2001 (Volume XX, Number 1, Issue 67) issue of Mass-Pocha, the publication of the JGSGB. This is the third and final installment of that article.)

Economic and Social Structure (Continued)

After the Russian Revolution, many Jews were thrilled by the toppling of the czar, the abolition of the Pale and its restrictions, and the end of school and university quotas. Jews flooded into cities. Many of the new Soviet leaders were Jews, including Trotsky, Kamentz, Aronovitch, and Rosenfeld (even Lenin may have had Jewish ancestry). As part of their general opposition to religion, the Soviets persecuted Jewish religious officials, but Jews became a recognized nationality among the many Soviet nationalities.

The German invasion of the Soviet Union progressed through places where many Jews lived, which again became "bloodlands." In Belarus alone, 800,000 Jews were murdered, 90 percent of the population. Most of those who survived had fled eastward. In addition, many Belarusian Jews who had previously moved to Leningrad and Moscow also survived.

It was a Russian canard that Ivan fought while Moshe lived in Tashkent (Uzbekistan). On the contrary, the 500,000 Jews who served in the Red Army was as high a percentage of fighters as any other Soviet nationality. They were the third-most-decorated group (army anti-Semitism probably kept that figure lower than it should have been) and almost 200,000 Jews were killed.

Today, the Jewish population of Belarus is about 55,000.
